Instructions for ordering textbooks from MBSDirect:

1. Go to <http://bookstore.mbsdirect.net/covenant.htm>.
2. Click "Let's Get Started" in the middle of the page.
3. Under Term, select "MEd Summer 2018"
4. Under Site, select "M.Ed. Program"
5. Type in the course ID
6. Continue to select each of your courses, then click the blue arrow at the bottom "View Your Materials"
7. Choose the format you would like for each of the required materials and click the green button " Add Selected to Cart"
8. Next click the blue arrow, "Proceed to Checkout"
9. You can add supplemental "Grade Builders" to your cart (not required) or just click the blue button, "No thanks, Continue to checkout"
10. Review your cart and click the blue button "Check out now"
11. If you have previously purchased through MBS, you can log into your account. If not, create a new account.
12. Enter your shipping/billing address, as well as your Student ID, then click the blue button, "Choose your shipping method"
13. Select shipping method, then click the blue button, "Select payment option"
14. Enter your payment information then click the blue button, "Review your order" for final review and confirmation.

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
