- Payment may be made by credit/debit card at scots.covenant.edu/PayStudentBill.html (processing fee applies, Discover or MasterCard only), or by cash/check. Credit card payments must be received by 7:00 pm in order to be posted the next business day. Check payment, either by self or third party, must accompany the registration form. **Be sure to include your Banner ID with identification of payment. Payment is not accepted by PayPal.**
- Tuition and fees are assessed on **May 27**. Interest will be added at the end of June *on the last business day of the month at 4:00 pm* on the unpaid balance at the rate of 1.17% per month. Returning students may not register until all financial obligations from the previous term have been satisfied.
- Financial aid grants may not be used to fund the tuition deposit required at registration.
- Note:** Individuals choosing to drop a course after **May 26 (late registration and drop/add period: May 16 - May 26)** will not receive a refund and are responsible to pay total course tuition and fees. This policy is in compliance with Federal and fiscal regulations. No exceptions may be made.
