- 2. Payments may be made by check through US postal system, or online by credit/debit card (a convenience fee of up to 4% will be added) or electronic check (a processing fee of \$1 will be added) at scots.covenant.edu. Select the option "PayStudentBill". Payments made online by 7 pm will be posted the following business day by 9 am. Payments made online after 7 pm will be posted a day later. Payments made online on a payment deadline day before 4 pm will be posted that day after 4 pm. Check payment, either by self or third party, must accompany the registration form.

Please note that online bill pay through your bank is not an electronic payment. Your bank will print and mail a check to us. Please allow at least seven days for the check to arrive.

Payments may be made in the Accounting Office by cash or checks (no fee charged) or by credit/debit card (a convenience fee of 2.75% will be added). Payments may be made in the Accounting Office are posted daily by 4 pm.

- 3. Tuition and fees are assessed on May 1 and interest will be added *on the last business day of the following month at 4:00 pm* on the unpaid balance at the rate of 1.17% per month. Returning students may not register until all financial obligations from the previous year have been satisfied.
- 4. Financial aid grants may not be used to fund the tuition deposit required at registration.
- 5. See Refund Policy in Graduate School of Education catalog. Tuition deposit is not refundable.
- 6. **Note:** Individuals choosing to drop a course after May 1 (late registration and drop/add period: April 16-May 1) will not receive a refund and are responsible to pay total course tuition and fees. This policy is in compliance with Federal and fiscal regulations. No exceptions may be made. See Withdrawal Refund Policy of the GSE catalog.

Note: The Tuition Reduction Plan offers an incentive for multiple educators from the same school who participate in the Master of Education Program. The details of the plan include adjustment in tuition at the following rates:

- a. 10% reduction for individuals with two students enrolled from the same school
- b. 20% reduction for individuals with three students enrolled from the same school
- c. 25% reduction for individuals with four or more students enrolled from the same school
- d. The principal or headmaster must submit an official letter listing participants in the Tuition Reduction Plan from his/her school each year that you are eligible for the plan. Upon receipt of registration forms and initial deposit, the tuition reduction will be applied to participants. This letter must be submitted each academic year for eligible applicants to receive tuition reduction benefits.

To activate the plan, request the letter from your administrator to be sent to Mrs. Lindsey Fain, Master of Education, Covenant College, 14049 Scenic Highway, Lookout Mountain, GA 30750; OR lindsey.fain@covenant.edu.

Any financial grants, loans, tuition remission, tuition reduction, and awards received after the date of registration will be credited to your account. Students participating in the Tuition Reduction Plan, receiving tuition remission, or who are a Covenant Fellow will receive the discount as a financial aid distribution.

<u>Deferment Status:</u> Returning students who have previously received federal student loans must register by April 15 in order to remain in deferment status. The term of attendance for **federal financial aid** purposes will be considered May 1 through February 1. Federal aid will be earned on a prorated basis up to 60% of the term of attendance.

Note re: books and materials: Students are responsible to order appropriate textbooks for each course. A textbook list is included with registration materials on the graduate website, and is included in each course syllabus.

IV. HOUSING REGISTRATION

Master of Education students who choose to live on campus are housed in Maclellan and Rymer Hall. We are able to accommodate married couples who are *both* enrolled in the MEd at the rate for two persons per suite. *Family members* (children or non-student spouse) and friends (non-students) may not be housed on campus.
